simple present	always, every ..., never, normally, often, seldom, sometimes, usually, If-Satz Typ I (If I talk, ...)
<i>he speaks</i>	
simple past	yesterday, 2 minutes ago, in 1990, the other day, last Friday, If-Satz Typ II - If it rained, it would get wet.
<i>he spoke</i>	
present perfect simple	already, ever, just, never, not yet, so far, till now, up to now
<i>he has spoken</i>	
past perfect simple	already, just, never, not yet, once, until that day If-Satz Typ III (If it had rained, it would have gotten wet.
<i>he had spoken</i>	
will - future I simple	in a year, next ..., tomorrow If-Satz Typ I (If it rains, it will get wet.) Vermutung: I think, probably, perhaps
<i>he will speak</i>	
going to - future I simple	in one year, next week, tomorrow
<i>he is going to speak</i>

present progressive	at the moment, just, just now, Listen!, Look!, now, right now
<i>he is speaking</i>	
past progressive	when, while, as long as
<i>he was speaking</i>	
present perfect progressive	all day, for 4 years, since 1993, how long?, the whole week
<i>he has been speaking</i>	
past perfect progressive	for, since, the whole day, all day
<i>he had been speaking</i>	
will-future I progressive	in one year, next week, tomorrow
<i>he will be speaking</i>	
going to - future I progressive
